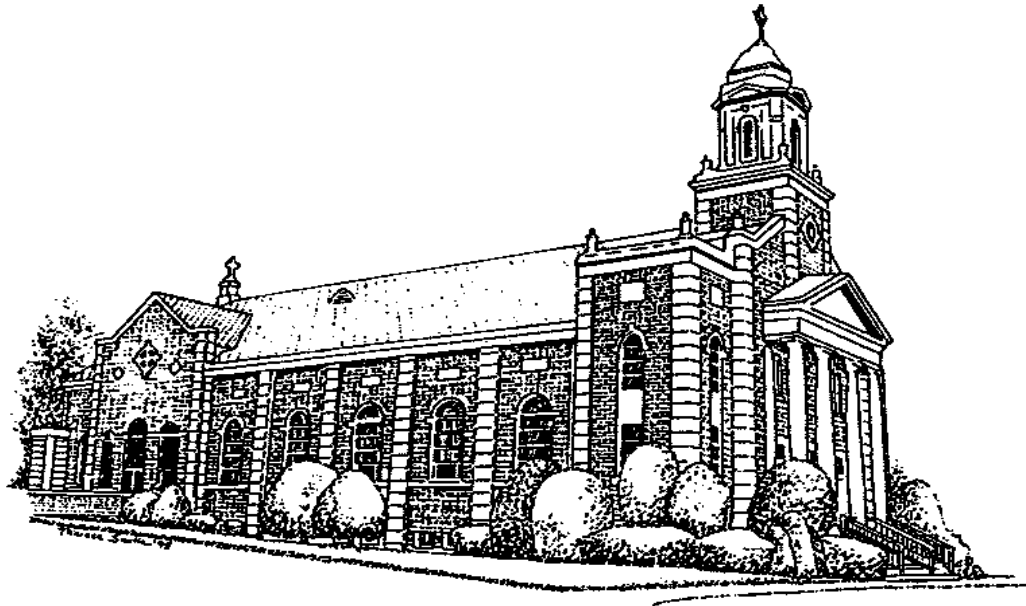

The priest frequently uses this ancient prayer posture, extending his hands to his sides, slightly elevated. *Orans* means "praying." Early Christian art frequently depicts the saints and others standing in this posture, offering their prayers and surrendering themselves, with hands uplifted to the Lord, in a gesture that echoes Christ's outstretched arms as He offered himself on the Cross.

MONETARY COLLECTION for HONDURAS

Sr. Teresita will be in Connecticut in October and will speak at the 4 PM Mass on the 8th, and the 10:30 AM Mass on the 9th. We will also have a special monetary collection for Honduras next weekend **October 8th & 9th**. 100% of the funds collected will be given to Sr. Teresita Gonzales in Honduras for the following ministries:

1. **COPPROME**, a home for children in El Progreso. The money is needed for school supplies, school uniforms, medicines, clothes, transportation, toiletries, etc. - whatever it takes to feed, clothe, educate and provide for the health needs of 35 children.
2. Scholarships to help children in remote mountain villages to continue their education.
3. Support families in El Progreso with basic food supplies.

BULB EXCHANGES

Saturday, **October 8th** between 8 AM - 12 PM the *Wethersfield Neighbor to Neighbor Energy Challenge* will hold a bulb swap at the **Transfer Station** at 100 Marsh Street in Wethersfield. Residents are invited to exchange 4 working incandescent bulbs for 4 new energy-efficient CFLs, which could save an average CT home up to \$125 a year. CFLs start saving energy as soon as they are installed, and are an easy first step to reducing energy waste.

Residents will also have the opportunity to sign up for a *free* in-home lighting visit from *Neighbor to Neighbor* at the exchange, to get up to 20 of the bulbs replaced in their home. To learn more about the program, visit www.CTEnergyChallenge.com/lighting.

SHELTER MEAL

Our first Shelter Meal for this season is **Thursday, October 13th**. We've been informed that we will be serving approximately 80 men at the Immaculate Conception Homeless Shelter which is located on Park Street in Hartford. Our meal is delicious, simple and the men love it! Please consider helping us provide this meal for those less fortunate. For this meal, we still need:

- 6 people to prepare a chicken dish (16 breasts *or* 16 legs *with* thighs *or* 24 thighs)
- 7 people to prepare a potato casserole (*recipe provided*)
- 2 people to prepare a green bean casserole (*recipe provided*)
- 2 people to provide fruit (25 pieces)
- 2 people to provide milk or juice (3 gallons)

All food is delivered to the **north parking lot** of the church between **6:30-7 PM**. We leave the parking lot promptly at 7 PM. All cooked food must be *fully* cooked, hot & ready to serve.
